

CENTER FOR RESEARCH ON GLOBAL CATHOLICISM LAUNCHED

Saint Louis University established the Center for Research on Global Catholicism (CRGC) in September 2023 to support scholarship on how Catholicism migrated across time and space to become a global religion. Renowned researchers and St. Louis-area area archivists will study the nexus of Catholicism and culture at the CRGC.

In October, the center held a conference at SLU on the theme of global Catholicism and material culture. "Translations, Transgressions and Transformations: The Global Movement of Objects in Catholic Cultures" brought together scholars from around the world to examine the cultural mobility of Catholicism through the physical movement of objects like refined artworks, textiles, books and mundane, everyday items.

THE O'LOUGHLIN FAMILY CHAMPIONS CENTER

A new, best-in-class resource for SLU's student-athletes.

Construction of the more than 27,000-square-foot O'Loughlin Family Champions Center — a gathering place and academic hub for the University's 400-plus student-athletes — was completed in 2023, a milestone that was celebrated with a ribbon-cutting in October 2023.

The privately funded facility provides SLU's student-athletes with programming related to academic advising, spiritual development, sports performance, nutrition, wellness and sports psychology. Features include the Koman Family Fueling Station – a place where athletes can grab food and drinks, the Keith Phoenix Team Dining Room and the Centene Corporation Student Success Suite, where athletes can study and access tutoring and career services.



WHAT'S A BILLIKEN?

The Billiken is a mythical goodluck figure who represents "things as they ought to be." Before he was Saint Louis University's mascot, he was a national sensation. In 1908, art teacher Florence Pretz received a patent for her version of the

mythical figure. Later, the Billiken Co. of Chicago adopted the likeness, giving the Billiken its name and manufacturing Billiken statuettes.

In 1910, local sportswriters thought SLU football coach John Bender bore a striking resemblance to the impish creature, and SLU's football team was dubbed "Bender's Billikens." The public took up the moniker, and it became the official nickname of all SLU teams.
