ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ✓ Upgraded recycling infrastructure and signage at Chaifetz Arena to establish consistency with main campus' recycling program.
- ✓ Placed 4th in RecycleMania's E-Waste competition, salvaging 68,038 lbs. of electronics for recycling.
- ✓ Hosted two-day Global Reporting Initiative (GRI) training and certification program on sustainability reporting for campus and community members.
- ✓ Consolidated online resources through greenbilliken.slu.edu for SLU students and staff to access tools for sustainable campus life.
- ✓ Educated over 1,000 faculty, staff and students on single-stream campus recycling
- ✓ Added 1,500 recycling bins to on-campus apartments
- ✓ Held seminars and discussions like, 'Conversations on Climate Change info sessions'

INNOVATIONS

- ✓ Added a "Director of Sustainability and Benchmarking" to Facilities Services Division, dedicating a well-networked position to enhance sustainability of campus operations.
- ✓ Defined and promoted the identity of the "Green Billiken" to boost sustainability as a social and cultural norm, supported by the Sustainability Advisory Council.
- Hosted a "Sustainability Expo" for campus and community partners to showcase how they support sustainability on SLU's campus. Over forty partners provided information that spanned dining, student groups, construction, and alternative transportation.
